## Steam has key role in shift to 'green cleaning'

Businesses that require commercial or heavy-duty cleaning need to understand the risks chemical exposure poses to staff during daily cleaning processes.

Murray McDonald, Director of Duplex Cleaning Machines, an exhibitor at CleanScene 2012 in Sydney this month, says employees as well as contract cleaners responsible for cleaning tasks are absorbing toxic chemicals through inhaling and skin contact.

He says a shift is under way from the use of toxic chemicals to high-temperature dry steam cleaning in sectors such as healthcare.

"High temperature steam instantly degreases, disinfects and detail cleans any surface or equipment," he says.
